

## Your dollars at work throughout the year...

Through our network of trained volunteers, using their experience and knowledge, Somerset County United Way is able to leverage each dollar invested to achieve the maximum impact in our local community. No matter how much you give, every dollar helps build community and improve lives.

Below are examples of ways that Somerset County United Way maximizes the value of your dollars in the community:

**\$50 per week for a year...**

...provides 8 months of outpatient substance abuse treatment for a person recovering from addiction.

**\$35 per week for a year...**

...provides a meaningful daycare service of recreational and therapeutic programming for children and adults aged 5 - 21 with developmental disabilities.

**\$25 per week for a year...**

...provides two weeks of emergency shelter for a homeless family of four, alleviating stress and helping to establish some stability.

**\$12.50 per week for a year...**

...provides three at-risk teens with a supervised, safe and fun place to go after school, helping them avoid getting in trouble and giving them the opportunity to learn and grow in a positive environment.

**\$10 per week for a year...**

...provides unemployed or underemployed individuals with career counseling, interview coaching, resume preparation, networking advice and job search support.

**\$3.50 per week for a year...**

...feeds a hungry family for two months, alleviating stress and providing the nutrition necessary for success both at home and in school.

**\$5 per week for a year...**

...provides transportation to medical services for veterans, persons with disabilities, the elderly and residents in our service area who do not have another means of transportation.

**\$1 per week for a year...**

...enables a young girl from a low-income family to learn character development and leadership skills.
